Running for two three-week sessions from **Saturday, 13 June to Saturday, 25 July 2015**, students may choose to join us for one or both sessions. With plenty of exciting new courses running as well as our long-standing favourites, there is something for everyone!

New for 2015, we have a selection of English Language modules on offer, including **English for Business**, **English for Theatre & Film**, and **Key Skills for Academic Study**. These modules, intended to run in both sessions one and two, are for students with an IELTS of 5.5 or above, and offer the opportunity for students to strengthen their vocabulary and academic skills in an English speaking environment.

You'll also notice a number of exciting new additions to our regular module catalogue. These include a new British History module, **Monarchy: A Royal History of London**, as well as **Working Across Cultures in a Global World**, which will enable the student to identify, consider, and understand cultural differences, and use these skills in a work environment. **Writing for Children** aims to present budding authors with new composition techniques as well as looking at the ethics, the business and the analysis of children's literature.



Students have the opportunity to experience and reflect upon UK law with **Introducing the English Legal System** in Session One, and **Law and Contemporary British Culture** in Session Two.

Due to its popularity in both Fall and Spring semesters, **Exploring Mind and Body Through Yoga** is joining the Summer School! A great class for committed *yogis* and beginners alike, it combines the physical, mental, spiritual and social dimensions of yoga.

For students with an interest in Tourism, **Destination London** is an interactive module that uses our capital city as its primary resource. Running exclusively in session one, this module introduces the student to all aspects of tourism and events and offers the opportunity to be taught by industry professionals.
