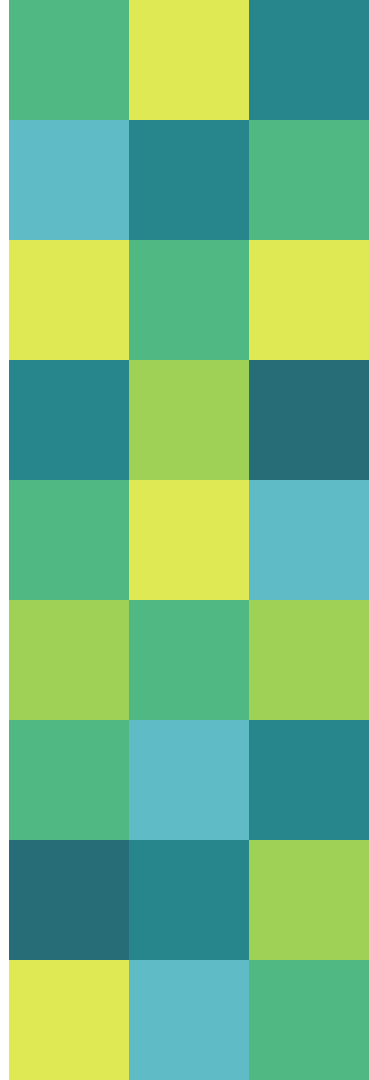

ID Card

- Gives you access to dining halls and dining dollars.
- If lost, deactivate your card using the GET App.
- Replacement card can be bought for \$25 from Parking and Transportation Services in the Conrad Welcome Center.
 - Residential students must visit Residential Life in Thompson Hall or the Welcome Center to obtain a temporary card.
 - Temporary Cards can also be activated for 4 days and **MUST** be returned to the Welcome Center, or a \$25 fine will be imposed

Additional Dining Points may be added to your card throughout the semester.

Students have the first two weeks of the semester to make a change.

Any 14 (2 meals a day) + 175 Dining Points

- Costs \$2,950 a semester
- Best if you usually skip a meal if plan on having a snack instead of a full meal

Any 10 + 475 Dining Points

- Costs \$3,075 a semester

Commuter Meal Plans

- 15 or 25 Meal Block Plans (individual trips throughout the semester)
- Point Plan Option

Changes in meal plans must be made on your BASC online account at basc1.org!

How to Use Dining Points

- At any of the previously mentioned locations you will either order a meal off a menu, or pick up a premade meal
- There are prices listed for each item
- That is the price you will be charged from your Dining Points Account
- Simply swipe your card and you are all set!
- Can ONLY be used on-campus!
- Dining points are tax exempt.
